# **Admission Requirements**

#### **Applicant Categories**

The following categories are used to classify all applicants for admission to KPU. Applicants in all categories are subject to published admission requirements.

#### HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE

An applicant who is a graduate, or will be graduating from, a BC Secondary school prior to the start of the standard term of admission (or the equivalent from another school system in Canada or another country). Applicants who have completed homeschooling may be considered on a case-by-case basis and may require supplementary evidence of academic ability.

#### **TRANSFER**

An applicant who has successfully completed 9 or more credits above the preparatory level from a recognized post-secondary institution.

#### **MATURE**

An applicant who will be 19 years of age or older on the first day of the standard term of admission.

#### **VISITING**

A visiting student is someone who is attending a home institution and wishes to spend a period of time up to one year studying at KPU with the intent of taking credit earned at KPU back to the home institution. Visiting students must provide a Letter of Permission from their home institution.

#### **Undergraduate Admission**

- » Meet KPU's English proficiency requirement
- » Have graduated high school (secondary school) OR completed 9+ credits of undergraduate-level credits

#### **Post-Baccalaureate Admission**

- » Meet KPU's English proficiency requirement
- » Successful completion of a recognized undergraduate degree

#### **Graduate Admission**

- » Meet KPU's English proficiency requirement
- » Have graduated from a bachelor's degree program with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.67

In addition to the general undergraduate, post-baccalaureate, and graduate admission requirements noted here, many programs will have additional program requirements.

## **English Proficiency Requirement**

As English is the primary language of study at KPU, all applicants must meet the English proficiency requirement in order to be admitted. An applicant can fulfill the English proficiency requirement through successful completion of any of the options listed below.

#### **HIGH SCHOOL COURSES**

- » Completion of BC English Studies 12, English First Peoples 12 or Literary Studies 12 with a minimum grade of C+ (or equivalents)
- » As part of the Adult Dogwood Diploma, completion of English Studies 12 with a minimum grade of C+
- » Completion of IB (International Baccalaureate) English A (HL or SL) with a minimum grade of 3 (or C+)
- » Completion of AP (Advanced Placement) English Language and Composition or AP English Literature and Composition with a minimum grade of 2 (or C+)

#### **KPU COURSES**

- » Completion of ELST 0381 and ELST 0383 (or equivalents) with a minimum grade of B in both, or ELST 0381 with a minimum grade of B and a KPU placement score higher than ELST 0383 level
- » Completion of one of ENGQ 1091, ENGQ 1092 or ENGQ 1099 (or equivalents) with a minimum grade of C

#### **LANGUAGE SCHOOL PATHWAY COURSES**

- » Completion of ILAC Pathway 3.3/3.4
- » ILSC Advanced 2

#### **UNDERGRADUATE COURSES**

- » Completion of 3 credits of undergraduate English (ENGL) with a minimum grade of C- from a recognized post-secondary institution where English is the primary language of instruction
- » Graduation from a baccalaureate degree, or two-year diploma program, or successful completion of two years of study (60 credits) at the undergraduate level, with a minimum CGPA of 2.0, at a recognized post-secondary institution where English is the primary language of instruction

- »Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL): iBT 88 or higher, with no sub score less than 20, taken within the last two years from the term of admission
- » Accuplacer English Assessment test, kpu.ca/test/english/ accuplacer


