- 2-year degree program.
- Available Hybrid Mode (in-person or online guided learning).
- Perfect for transferring to research or teaching universities to complete a bachelor's degree or serves as a credential to enter the labour market.
- Equivalent to the first two years of a four-year degree in the Arts.
- Enhance effective written and oral communications.
- Foster teamwork and leadership abilities.
- Acquire research, evaluative skills and apply theoretical knowledge.
- Provides a broad academic foundation and pathway to further study or job market entry.



Entry Requirements



Canadian high school (Grade 12) diploma or equivalent with an overall average of C or better (2.0 on a 4.33 scale)

HSC GPA: 3.5 out of 5.0

If you have graduated from high school but do not meet the minimum grade levels, you may still be considered for admission if you have successfully completed at least 24 academic post-secondary credits at a recognized institution. 2

IELTS - **6.5** or better with a minimum of **6.0** in the writing band, or equivalent (for students whose first language is not English).



- MBA Direct: (Business & STEM): CGPA 3.00 & Above (Out of 4.00)
- Note: No GMAT or Work Experience is required. Nonbusiness graduates can also apply with Proof of English only.

MBA Foundation is discontinued, only MBA direct eligible students can apply and get the PAL. 2

AND HAVE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Acceptable score on a Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) or the Graduate Record Examinations (GRE) that has been written in the last five years **OR**
- An appropriate Canadian professional designation or equivalent international designation (e.g. CPA, CA, CGA, CMA, CHRP or P.Eng) OR
- Bachelor's degree in business (e.g., Business Administration (BBA) degree, Bachelor Commerce (BCom) or STEM from a recognized university) OR
- A minimum of three (3) years documented professional or management experience with evidence of career progression and relevant education and/or training.




