Established in 1992, Kiwi College of New Zealand offers three unique, renown and prestigious university foundation programmes University Foundation Studies (UFS) (Level 4), University Foundation Certificate (UFC) (Level 4) and University Foundation Certificate (UFC) (Level 3), all approved and recognised by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority (NZQA). Both the UFS (Level 4) and the UFC (Level 4) meet the general entry requirements for undergraduate degree programmes at New Zealand universities.

Kiwi College has formed a strategic academic partnership with Massey University, ensuring that graduates from the UFS (Level 4) or UFC (Level 4) programmes gain direct entry into bachelor's degree programmes at Massey University.



## University Foundation Certificate (UFC) (Level 3)

### 1. Aim of the Programme

To prepare learners who plan to study New Zealand qualifications at NZQCF level 4 and higher. It caters to those who lack the necessary background knowledge, experience or proficiency for academic tertiary study in the New Zealand context. The programme provides learners with the skills, capabilities, knowledge and attributes needed to progress and succeed in their chosen field of study and/or employment pathway in New Zealand, particularly in the construction, information science or business study fields.

### 2. Education Pathway

- UFS (Level 4)
- UFC (Level 4)

### 3. Programme Admission Requirements

- Age Requirement: 16 years or older
- Academic Requirement: Equivalent to New Zealand School Year 10; or junior high school education from their country of origin
- English Language Requirement: An overall IELTS General or Academic test score of 5 with no band score lower than 5; or equivalent to any other NZQA Rule 22 recognised English proficiency level; or New Zealand Certificate in English Language (General) (Level 3)

## University Foundation Certificate (UFC) (Level 4) and University Foundation Studies (UFS) (Level 4)

### 1. Aim of the Programme

To equip learners with the essential knowledge and skills in a range of subject areas, and to build their academic English proficiency, confidence, tertiary study skills, and capabilities needed to progress and succeed in their chosen field of study and/or employment pathway in New Zealand.

### 2. Education Pathway

This certificate builds on the UFC (Level 3) and leads to further tertiary study or training at NZQCF Level 5 or bachelor's degree related to the graduates' chosen fields of study.

### 3. Programme Admission Requirements

- Age Requirement: 16 years or older
- Academic Requirement: Secondary school study equivalent to New Zealand School Year 12; or secondary school study from their country of origin, or UFC (Level 3) \*

\* Students holding a UFC (Level 3) certificate are exempt from submitting evidence of English language proficiency.

- English Language Requirement: An overall IELTS General or Academic test score of 5.5 with no band score lower than 5; or equivalent to any other NZQA Rule 22 recognised English proficiency Level; or New Zealand Certificate in English Language (Applied) (Level 3)

Students need to complete SIX courses, made up of 5 compulsory courses, and 1 out of 2 elective courses.
