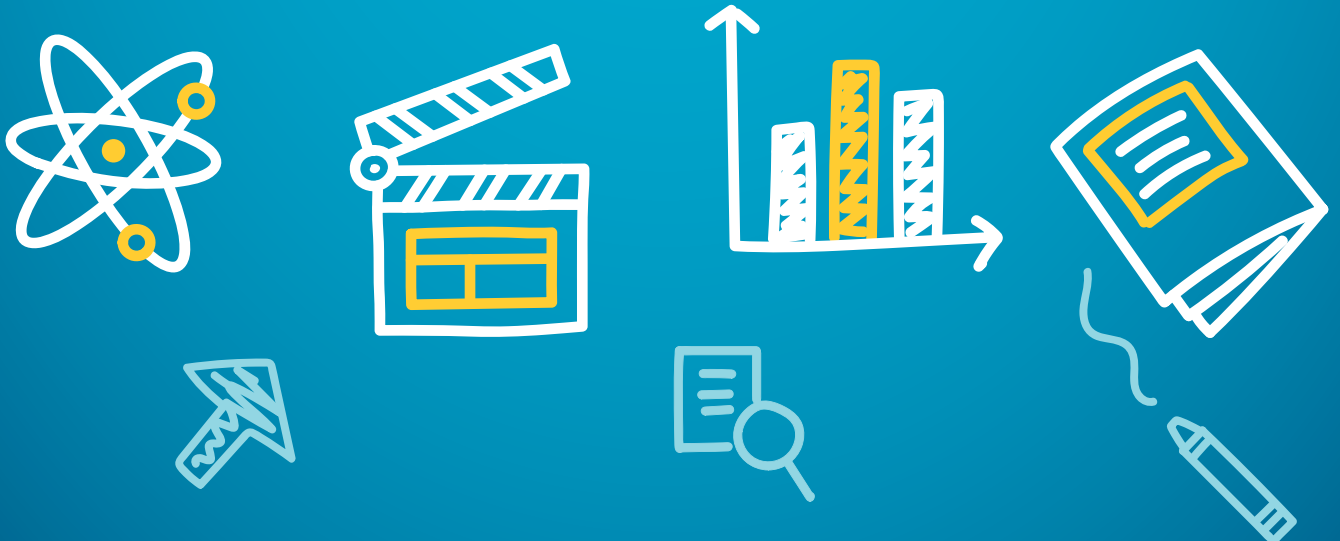

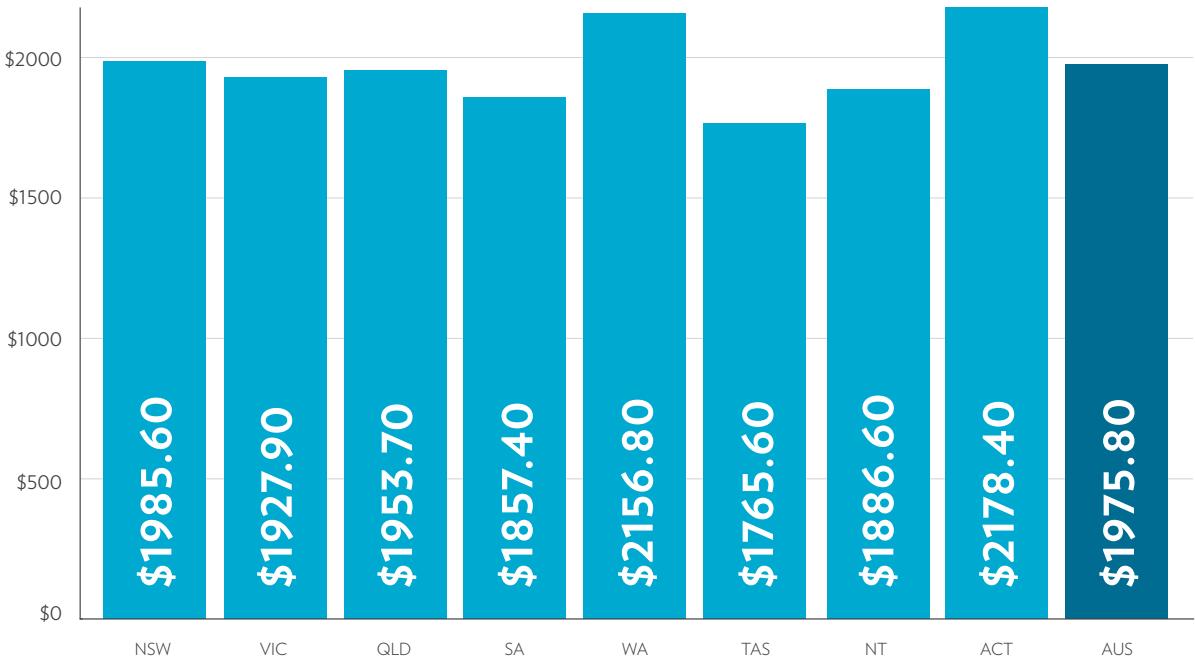

CAMPUS FACILITIES



RESEARCH INSTITUTE FOR SPORT AND EXERCISE (UCRISE)

The University of Canberra Research Institute for Sport and Exercise (UCRISE) is a research and innovation institute established in 2014. Combining **six research themes**, the institute was created to support the University's sporting aspirations through strategic planning and leadership, the co-ordination of sport-related research projects involving both staff and students, consultancy across the University, and development of external partnerships.



UC HOSPITAL

The University of Canberra Hospital (UCH): Specialist Centre for Rehabilitation, Recovery and Research is the largest purpose-built rehabilitation centre in the ACT and surrounding region, with capacity for 140 inpatient beds, 75-day places and additional outpatient services.

UCH features dedicated therapy spaces, including a hydrotherapy pool, therapeutic gyms, and kitchens to promote independence. There are also outdoor spaces, including a rehabilitation courtyard and recreational areas.

Students studying in the Faculty of Health will have classes in the new state-of-the-art Clinical Education and Research Centre (CERC) – the University's shared teaching and research space at the hospital.



SPORTING COMMONS

Our sporting facilities are being developed on campus to help the University become one of Australia's leading tertiary sports institutions in scholarships and research.

Facilities located within the Sporting Commons include gymnasiums, medical and rehabilitation areas, plunge pools, a sauna, a main oval and skills field, and a purpose-built bocce court for Special Olympics ACT.

The Sporting Commons are benefitting our students, with honours and doctoral students working alongside the Brumbies, the AIS and the University of Canberra Capitals to gain valuable experience while they study.



ROBOTICS LAB

Led by Associate Professor Damith Herath, our Collaborative Robotics Laboratory is the hub of our industry-lead, cutting edge development and research work in the area of robotics.

Established in 2017, what started as a group of interested, like-minded staff and students has now become the home to many enterprising industry partnerships, award-winning research projects, and the genesis of growth in the area of robotics at UC.

Our dedicated team of researchers, HDR candidates, students, and professional staff work on various projects in robotics and human-robot interaction, closely involving our industry partners and the arts, education, and health communities to explore new and innovative concepts.

OUR SPORT STRATEGY

The University of Canberra is committed to becoming Australia's leading university for sport education. By 2026, our goal is to be among the top-three universities in Australia and the top 50 in the world for sport science.

SPORT WALK OF FAME

Sport lies at the heart of UC and is part of our history, present and future. In recognition of former students who have made an impact on the sporting industry the UC Sport Walk of Fame was launched. Inductees come from a number of different sports and are not restricted to athletes, with sports administrators, officials and coaches also amongst the inaugural inductees. Internationally acclaimed sporting stars such as Olympians Lauren Jackson (basketball) and Petria Thomas (swimming) and Australian rugby union player George Gregan are among the former students to be inducted in 2022.

WORK INTEGRATED LEARNING (WIL)

Work Integrated Learning (WIL) is central in our approach to education, and something we strive to include in all of our undergraduate courses. Through a variety of different programs and opportunities, WIL is designed to help students boost their employability by getting out of the classroom and into real world workplaces.

WIL Project, or activity that engages individuals or teams to respond to a real-world problem or opportunity under the guidance of the faculty and client, or the faculty.

Placements or internships involve work experience (that takes place at the workplace) under the supervision of the faculty and the workplace supervisor.

Simulation, which can be a project or activity, involves authentic work experience that is undertaken in a simulated work environment, under the guidance of a supervisor. Simulation may be in the physical environment or virtual.

Field work is an approved activity that involves observing, collating information and/ or collecting data/ specimens.

Expenses may be payable to cover costs associated with training and checks for internships and placements, uniforms or personal safety equipment, travel and relocation to placement site.

YOUR PATHWAY TO UC

The University of Canberra College (UCC), located on the UC Bruce campus, became a joint venture between Navitas and the University of Canberra in 2015. UCC provides educational pathways to domestic, international, and Indigenous students, offering quality higher education opportunities to those who would not otherwise gain direct entry into the University. The suite of programs includes English language, enabling programs, and diploma courses.

INTERNATIONAL FOUNDATION STUDIES PROGRAM

The International Foundation Studies course is a one-year program for international students seeking admission to the first year of all undergraduate degrees at the University of Canberra. GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN ACADEMIC FOUNDATIONS (GCAF)

The Graduate Certificate in Academic Foundations (GCAF) is a pathway course that allows international students the opportunity to upgrade their qualification to an equivalent of an Australian Bachelor degree. This allows direct admission into selected University of Canberra postgraduate courses.

DIPLOMA PROGRAMS

If you're a domestic or international student aiming for an undergraduate degree but don't meet the entry requirements, UC offers diplomas in **Business, Communication, Design, Information Technology, Health, and Science**. These diplomas provide the support you need to transition to university, with up to one year of credit towards your undergraduate degree upon successful completion.

NON-TUITION COSTS

Student Services and Amenities Fee (SSAF) is a fee for student services and amenities of a non-academic nature, such as sporting and recreational activities, employment and career advice, child care, financial advice and food services. In 2025, the maximum fee for a full-time student will be \$365.00 and \$273.75 for a part-time student in 2025.

ADDITIONAL COSTS

Depending on the course you're enrolled in and your units of study, you may encounter other costs.

It's worth noting that UC charges for services such as on-campus parking, printing and photocopying. Plus, you may need access to specific equipment to meet the requirements of a unit. This could include: textbooks or other reference materials, digital devices and associated software, uniforms or personal safety equipment, costs associated with training and checks for internships and placements. You'll need to consider costs associated with getting a student visa too.
